Draft Standards for review/comment

Standards Australia and its committee WS-014 have for some time been working on a review of AS/NZS 3500.5:2000.

This review is now in its final public comment stage and is available for download and comment at the SAI Global Draft Standards webpage, also the committee has endeavoured to coordinate any amendments with the similar clauses in other parts of the standard.
