Plumbing and Drainage Circulars NSW

The Committee on Uniformity of Plumbing and Drainage Regulations (CUPDR) meeting on 21

November 2007, the committee agreed to a number of variations and additions to the AS/NZS 3500:2003 to the NSW Code of Practice. The following circulars advise of these changes:

- Circular 2007/1 Changed requirements for water meter installation
- Circular 2007/2 Changed requirements for backflow prevention for rainwater tank installations
- Circular 2007/3 Maintenance of roof water collection and use systems
- Circular 2007/4 Changed soffit requirements
- Circular 2007/5 Installation of greywater diversion devices and greywater treatment systems
- Circular 2007/6 Installation of assisted bathing systems backflow prevention

These Circulars have now been approved for release. However, unlike previous notifications, hardcopies of the circulars will no longer be circulated. Rather, the circulars are available for downloading from the DWE website at: <u>http://www.deus.nsw.gov.au/water/Plumbing.asp</u>

The Australian National Plumbing Forum will also be in Perth October 2008 – More details in later issues.


